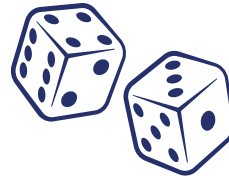


Play Bunco!

Academic connections!

Math Skills

- Addition & Counting: Use scorecards to tally points
- Probability: Discuss odds of rolling combos (e.g., three 5s)
- Pattern Recognition: Identify repeating outcomes
- Mental Math: Multiply, subtract, or divide dice totals orally

History & Research

Great for middle and high school students. Prompt topics include:

- Bunco's origin and etymology
- "Bunco Squads" in 20th-century law enforcement
- Crime, swindles, and how the game evolved into fun family play

SEL & Inclusion

Teamwork & Sportsmanship: Reflect on communication and cooperation

Focus & Turn-Taking: Teach patience without screens

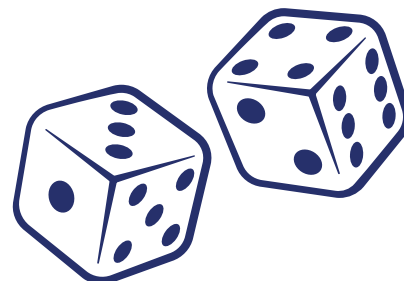
Quiet Bunco Option: Use hand signals instead of bells for sensory-friendly play
