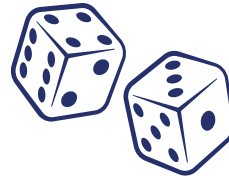


# Play Bunco!

*A fun, movement-based dice game for teaching math, probability, and more!*

## Why Bunco?

Bunco is a fast-paced, easy-to-learn dice game that helps students:

- Practice counting, addition, and basic arithmetic
- Understand probability and patterns
- Work together, build memory, and learn sportsmanship
- Explore a fun slice of history

Start with a set of dice, this guide with attached resources, and the online game at [PlayBunco.com](https://PlayBunco.com). It's a fun way to introduce patterns, probability, and quick addition.

## How to play in class!



- Students play in teams of 2 at tables of 4
- Each table needs 3 standard six-sided dice
- First team to 21 points wins the round
- Teams rotate tables based on wins/losses
- Players roll to match the round number (1–6). A triple match (e.g., 3•3•3 in round 3) scores 21 points = a Bunco
